

## **Disciple Project 1**

## Part 1 - Prayer

Matthew 28: <sup>18</sup> Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

**Prayer:** Ask for God's heart and mind. That is what He wants.

- Start praying about this discipleship effort and always asking for God's heart and mind.
  - Left to our thoughts and ideas, "we will not be as successful, or will not do as God would want us to".
- Pray, "Who you should ask to join your group?"
- Have the group list who they should start praying for regarding their salvation, then distribute it to everyone.

## Pray for their salvation every week.

- How could you or the group reach out to those not yet a disciple?
- Discuss when or where to share the website as a whole or certain articles.
- Pray for the personal needs of those you are praying for.
- Love who they love; that is meaningful and helps you connect. It needs to be authentic.
- Discuss printing articles to give to potential disciples, when and why you should use them.
- As a group, discuss other potential uses of the website.

## **Share Share Share**

- The group should go through the website and at least read and listen to series 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, and do discussion questions together.
  - This exercise will prepare you for sharing the website, where to locate talking points.
- Discuss together how to share the content of the website. For example, discuss giving out business-size cards with the website address.



- Write your contact info on the back of the card for them to reach you. You can send the card artwork to a commercial printer from the website as well.
- New disciples should be brought into the group.
- When the group gets too large, form new groups.
  - o The size of an effective group depends on your local culture.
