Group prayer. Ask God for His heart and mind in this study. That is His desire, and he will answer.

I want to tell you a story about a friend who worked for hospice in our area of the US. For the most part, hospice is help for people and families who are in their last days of life. Unfortunately, that is not all they do, but for our story, we will focus on that.

This friend learned what people saw at the end of life. Some believed and saw the portal to heaven. He said it was peaceful to watch. Usually, others in the room were sad in those last minutes, but there was peace about what was about to take place.

One day he said, I have to quit; I can't take it. It is okay if they know Jesus and which portal they are going through. There is a heavenly portal God promises for those that believe him. They knew they were going to Jesus; some could even see Him and or family who had previously passed as they entered the portal.

Those that did not have their name written in the book of life seem to know and see their fate, the hell portal they were going through. They, along with others in

the room would be so scared. They appeared to be able to see through the portal and what was on the other side. My friend told me he couldn't bear watching that traumatic experience: the extreme pain, fear, and stress. He had to quit hospice.

When we are up against those last days, we will look down on those portals and know where we are going. What portal do you think you will see if facing the final moments? Why do you say that?
