

## The People that Satan Fears

James 4:4-7

<sup>4</sup>You adulterous people, <sup>[a]</sup> don't you know that friendship with the world means enmity against God? Therefore, anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God. <sup>5</sup> Or do you think Scripture says without reason that he jealously longs for the spirit he has caused to dwell in us <sup>[b]</sup>? <sup>6</sup> But he gives us more grace. That is why Scripture says:

"God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble." [c]

<sup>7</sup> Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Job 1:20-22

<sup>20</sup> At this, Job got up and tore his robe and shaved his head. Then he fell to the ground in worship <sup>21</sup> and said:

"Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked I will depart. [a]
The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away; may the name of the Lord be praised."

<sup>22</sup> In all this, Job did not sin by charging God with wrong doing.
